Attendance & Class Participation	10%

Preparation & Homework	10% *Students are expected to read the textbook assignment before each class. *Homework (creative writing, reading or workbook exercises) will be assigned every class.

Mid-Term Exam	20% (Lessons 15 - 17) *Review Quiz for Lesson 17 will be included. *Listening comprehension and Kanji also will be included.
Final Exam	30% (Lessons 15 - 21) *Review Quiz for Lesson 21 will be included. *Listening comprehension and Kanji also will be included.
